In addition, the candidate will demonstrate knowledge and skills relative to the design and logic of research and appropriate application of statistical methods and designs to a range of contemporary research questions in education science.

Candidates must have completed a doctoral degree in quantitative methods, educational research, statistics, psychometrics or related field prior to the begin date of this position; and provide evidence of competencies and interests noted above.
