Post Doctoral Fellow: Temple University Network of Cognition and Education Sciences IES Training Grant

Temple University's Department of Psychology and College of Education are seeking two Post-doctoral Fellows for an IES-funded collaborative training grant bridging the fields of cognitive and education sciences. We aim to prepare talented doctoral-level researchers to conduct interdisciplinary work in cognition and education. Candidates who have recently obtained doctorates in cognitive science, cognitive neuroscience or cognitive development will be mentored in learning how to conduct rigorous research on educational topics. Candidates who have recently obtained doctorates in education-related fields will be mentored in cognitive science and cognitive development topics.

Fellows will collaborate on publications and grant writing with two mentors from our team of four: Nora Newcombe (Psychology), Kathy Hirsh-Pasek (Psychology), Julie Booth (Education) and Annemarie Hindman (Education). Together, the mentors' research spans a wide range of topics, including spatial intelligence and learning; language, reading, science and mathematics learning and teaching; parenting and family processes; and educator professional development.

Fellowships include two years of funding and health benefits, beginning in summer/fall 2015. In the cover letter or research statement, please address how your work would fit with, and be advanced by, the research of at least two faculty mentors. Applications will be reviewed until the position has been filled.
